***Simplified Fireground Hydraulics***

**(Dep. Chief J. Burnham, Shelburne Center Fire)**

The class will cover the basics of fireground hydraulics. Emphasis will be on a working knowledge of water supply and water delivery rather than on calculations. Don't bring your calculator to class. There are several very basic concepts that, when understood, can allow your incident commander as well as your pump operator to make good decisions regarding water delivery and water application at a fire scene. These apply whether your district has a hydrant system or not.

***2-1/2 Story Dwelling Fires***

**Chief K. Galligan (Ret.), Brockton Fire Department**

Chief Galligan brings many years of experience as both a line officer and as a chief officer from a city with many of the typical New England 2 ½ story dwelling. Whether city or small town, the challenges you face in dealing with one of these fires are the same. This is an opportunity for you to learn from years of successes and failures. This course will address the apparatus, personnel, and water supply resources needed for these incidents. Strategies and tactics will be discussed in detail.
